Kevin Holley is Mobile Systems Design Manager in BT. He is responsible for helping to develop the standards for UMTS and GSM, and manages a project which involves primarily designing new services for Cellnet.

He has been active in the SMG community for 11 years, helping with the development of signalling for a short time before focusing on the data services, in particular RLP (layer 2 retransmission protocol), and the Short Message Service. Prior to working on GSM standards he was involved with the analogue mobile system in the UK (TACS), in particular developing an off-air signalling monitor.

In 1991 he was appointed chairman of the SMS group in SMG4 and the group successfully introduced a number of significant developments to the short message service under his guidance and leadership.
