Ed has 28 years experience in the Telecommunications Industry. Before joining Nokia in late 1998, Ed worked for Nortel Networks, where he held last held the position as Senior Manager Wireless Standards, and Rockwell Telecommunications, where he held various positions in Market Development, Product Planning and Technical Support for their digital transmission product lines.

Ed holds a BS in Physics from the University of Illinois.
