Re: MMS Transfer to OMA

Dear Mr. Laumen,

TSG-X thanks you for your correspondence dated 20 February 2004 regarding MMS transfer to OMA. We also thank you for your detailed review and identification of important issues of concern. Regarding those issues:

- 3GPP2 TSG-X supports the work of the OMA MMSG Landing Pad Task Force (LPTF) and suggests that both 3GPP and 3GPP2 make their inputs on the planning of the MMS work transfer directly to that group.
- Regarding the status of pre-transfer documents in 3GPP2, 3GPP2 plans to retain the ownership, final approval of any changes, and editorial maintenance of those documents. However, since the majority of MMS expertise may reside in OMA in the future, we do plan to be responsive to inputs from OMA regarding modifications to those documents.
- Regarding the details of work split proposed in your mark up of 23.140, the 3GPP MMS Stage 2, TSG-X plans to complete a similar exercise on our MMS Stage 2 document (X.S0016-200). We will submit that directly to the OMA MMSG LPTF but we will copy you at that time for reference.
- We also share your position that the execution of transfer of MMS work is subject to the resolution of applicable IPR/legal issues.

• Regarding 3GPP/3GPP2 "approval" of the transferred work, 3GPP2 TSG-X does plan to review the resultant OMA MMS specification drafts and make any comments of concern directly to OMA MMSG. Once we have confirmed that 3GPP2 requirements have been addressed, we plan to refer all network independent issues to OMA for resolution.
