Behrouz is currently a CT1 delegate and he is also a former TSG CT Vice Chair.



Behrouz has more than 27 years background in wireless telecom and mobile communications. He joined 3GPP in 2006 and has, during his more than 15 years in 3GPP, been contributing as a representative of handset manufacturer and chipset manufacturer. Behrouz has attended various working groups in 3GPP such as GERAN2, SA2 and CT1 covering a range of topics such as GERAN Evolution, SAES, CS Fallback, MTC, CloT, MINT and NPN. Behrouz maintains rapporteurship of a several specifications which are under CT1 remit and also served as the rapporteur of the ongoing Work Item of

"SAESx" family. In addition to his CT1 activities, he attended TSG CT on a regular basis from 2009 to 2022. During this period, he was elected as the TSG CT Vice Chair in 2017 and served for four years, from 2017 to 2021.

Prior to his standardization activities within 3GPP, he worked as a technical instructor, conducting technical training in GSM, GPRS and UMTS. Moreover, he worked as an adjunct professor at the Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm Sweden, where he also obtained a Masters degree in Engineering Physics, teaching a range of various courses in mathematics, from 1989 to 1995.
