Brief CV for Dr. Erlin Zeng



Dr. Erlin Zeng is a principle engineer in the CATT team. He has over 20 years' experience in wireless system research, and more than 14 years' experience in 3GPP standardization. He received his Bachelor's degree and Ph.D. degree from Xi'an Jiaotong University, China.

Erlin started his Ph.D. research in 2002, focusing on the multi-user MIMO algorithm and system design based on the MIMO-OFDM air interface. After several years' work in algorithm design and performance evaluation for the LTE physical layer, he joined Nokia in 2008 and started to participate 3GPP RAN1 meetings in 2009. During the period, he contributed to LTE topics such as MIMO, CA, TDD, and relaying, etc.. From 2013, Erlin jointed CATT and has been contributing to 3GPP RAN WG2. He had been actively participating in various topics including Mobility, MR-DC, UDC, IAB, SDT, MIMO, and MBS, etc. in RAN2.
